COMBATING DEFORESTATION POLICY

PURPOSE AND SCOPE

This policy has been established to set out BİM's commitments and practices for managing efforts to combat deforestation. At BİM, we are aware of the risks of deforestation that may result from our activities and consider the potential impacts of these risks on our business operations, the environment, and society. This policy applies not only to our operations but also to our suppliers and business partners, framing our approach to preventing deforestation across all our business processes.

PRINCIPLES OF IMPLEMENTATION

Deforestation and forest degradation intensify the impacts of climate change and lead to biodiversity loss, posing a significant threat to both the environment and the continuity of our operations. BİM strives to conduct its operations without forming adverse impacts on forests. The company makes efforts to prevent any negative effects on its operations and all stakeholders.

At BİM, we pay close attention to prioritizing sustainable resource use at every stage of our supply chain. By supporting responsible and sustainable raw material procurement, we aim to fulfill our environmental responsibilities while securing our long-term goals.

We are conscious of our influence on how our private-label and food products are produced and cultivated. For this reason, we place importance on ensuring that our supply chain is free from both legal and illegal deforestation and land conversion. As one of Turkey's leading food retailers, we seek to take responsible steps across our supply chain to mitigate the effects of deforestation and facilitate the transition to sustainable production models.

BİM places importance on eliminating deforestation in its private-label products. To this end, BİM strives to source the raw materials and products used in its private-label items with the objective of transitioning to sustainable production models.

ENFORCEMENT AND REVIEW

This policy entered into force on 19 September 2025 with the approval of BİM's Board of Directors. The Board of Directors holds overall responsibility for the functioning and implementation of this policy. All significant changes to this policy after its entry into force must be approved by the Board of Directors.
